Through CAEMBA we build dreams, dignity and hope.

All our efforts are aimed at providing a decent roof to low-income families and those in vulnerable situations, thus giving them an opportunity to grow and prosper. We also offer vocational training courses for women that are beneficiaries of CAEMBA, at our Women's Entrepreneurship House, in Atacames. In this way, we close the circle of poverty, by working comprehensively.

From April 2016 to June 2023, CAEMBA has produced and built:

- 379 temporary shelters for earthquake victims.
- 556 bamboo houses.
- 30 school classrooms.
- 10 temporary children's centers that operated up to 1 year after the earthquake. •
- 2 health centers, one dedicated to hospitalization of Covid-19 patients.
- 11 community centers, including the Women's Entrepreneurship House and the "Belleza en Bambú" Hair and Beauty Salon.

The CAEMBA houses are based on a prefabricated structure of wood and immunized bamboo, armed with galvanized bolts, with a prepainted galvalume roof. The house is mounted on reinforced concrete piles or on a subfloor. The CAEMBA house can be assembled in a single day and can also be disassembled and reassembled in another location with great ease.

• CAEMBA house with bathroom: 43 square meters, and has a cost from USD 4.500, depending on the terrain and the installations.
